



MAINTENANCE CORNER

Kitchen Diposal Do's and Don'ts

You can refresh you disposal by grinding lemon or orange peels periodically.

Do not feed your disposal; celery, lettuce, onion peels, corn husks or corn silks, potato skins, artichoke leaves, grease, egg shells, coffee grounds, bones of any kind, fish scales, glass, metal, rice, and oatmeal etc.

Your disposal is equipped with a reset button in the event of a jam. The reset button can usually be found on or near the bottom of the disposal unit and it is usually red in color. If the power is not restored, a service call may be in order.

Always run water through the disposal while it is in use.

Bathroom Etiquette

Do not dispose of baby wipes, cleaning wipes, diapers etc. in the toilet as they are not designed to be flushed. Also, please do not dispose "flushable" wipes in your toilet as they can still cause a backup in your plumbing lines. Only paper products that are designed to be flushed should be placed in your toilets.

Got Clogged?

- Most clogs can be removed with a plunger
- Place the plunger over the hole in the toilet bowl and push down with 3 powerful thrusts. This motion sends pressure down to the drain line to loosen the obstruction.
- If clog can not be removed after several attempts, please contact the maintenance help line (808) 839-4357
