#### **Update Your information**

We want to stay in contact with you as much as possible. Not only do we send out our newsletters, but we try our best to keep you up to date on what is going on in your neighborhood. From tree trimming to water shut offs we want to keep communication open with you. If you have changed your phone number or email address or if you know a neighbor that is not receiving our information, call or email us at the SOUTH RSO to update phone and email address information.

#### **AC Care**

Summer is here! As temperatures begin to rise outside, your AC will start working harder to keep your home cool. This is an extremely important time to care for and keep a close eye on your AC. Here are some tips on what you can do to help.

- Change filters monthly, or bi-weekly if you have pets.
- Check your drain line. Pour a cap full of bleach or vinegar down the drain line to keep it clear of any build-up to help keep the line from clogging and backing up which will cause the AC to stop working. Not sure where that is located? contact the RSO
- Set thermostat to the warmest comfortable setting, each degree about 75 degrees saves 3% of the energy used to cool your home.
- Make sure air intake registers are unobstructed.
- If you have not had your AC preventative maintenance completed within the last year, you can call maintenance or use the RENTCAFE app to place a work order.

#### **COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD**

Become a voice for your community! The CAB representative meets monthly with OMC community managers, maintenance managers and community directors and serve as community liaisons between the neighborhood and OMC management. #### **ILLEGAL PARKING**

Avoid the cost and trouble of retrieving a towed car. Remember to use your carport or garage when parking your vehicles as these have been provided for your convenience. Please keep in mind that there are no additional parking spaces allocated for vehicles displaced by storage or personal goods. Additionally, vehicles parked in driveways must fit within the driveway without blocking the sidewalk or street traffic. Under no circumstances shall any vehicle be allowed to park or driven on the lawn or in common areas.
