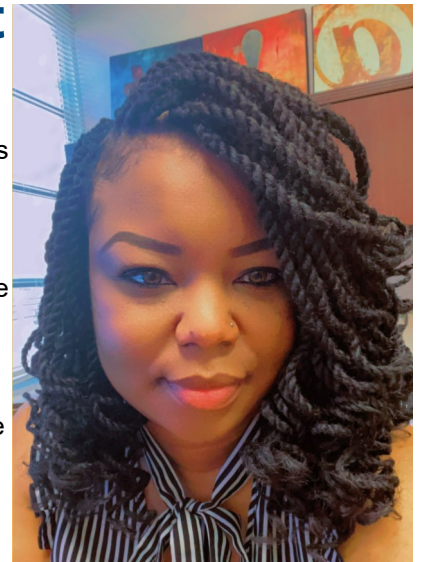

## Grout Maintenance

Grout is our best friend when it comes to keeping our tubs and showers sealed, but what about when it starts to crack, chip, and discolor? If you notice any cracks or missing grout, please make sure to call our maintenance team. They will ensure that it is properly replaced without causing further damage to the tub or area. To ward off mildew or ugly discoloration, a little baking soda, vinegar, and warm water will do wonders. If you prefer to bring in the big guns, ZEP Mold, Stain and Mildew Remover is our recommendation.
