Community Reminders

Chickens Are Not Pets

Feral chickens are creating nuisances by foraging in our communities, crowing at inconvenient hours, posing health concerns with their waste, and agitating household pets. More roaming chickens means more nuisances. OMC residents can help manage the nuisance by not feeding feral chickens and reducing the feral chicken population in their community.

- ⇒ Chickens are NOT accepted pets. Do not keep them in your yard or home.
- ⇒ Report chicken-nests or deceased chickens to your RSO.
- ⇒ Feeding feral chickens is illegal in Honolulu County.
- ⇒ Do not purposefully harm chickens or other wildlife.
- ⇒ Try spraying unwanted chickens with water to keep them out of your yard.
