Window Safety

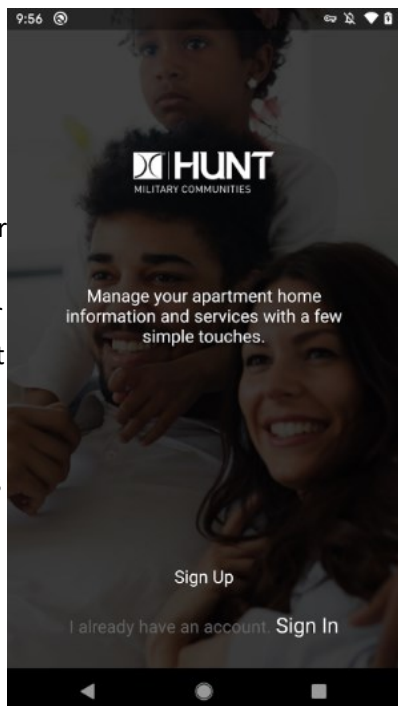
Warm weather and the urge to open a window pose a potential danger that many people don't realize until it's too late - **window falls**. Please check all the rooms in your home and make sure they are safe places for your children to play or nap.

- **Close it!** Close upstairs windows if an unattended child will be in the room.
- **Move it!** Anything that could become a ladder should be moved away from upstairs windows. Look for toys, boxes, beds, and other furniture kids could use to climb to the window.
- **Check it!** Routinely check your windows (while the children aren't watching) to ensure the locking mechanism is in proper working order. If a window lock isn't working properly, please call Maintenance.
- **Add it!** There are various options available that prevent the window from opening more than 4 inches. These child safety devices can be found at local hardware stores and online.



Are you Plugged in?

Make sure that you are connected to OMC through the Hunt Resident Portal. This app makes it easy to enter maintenance requests and keep track of them, allows you to make easy payments online, and lets you RSVP for upcoming events. Make sure that every adult in your home has their own account so that they have access to important updates and can enter maintenance requests when the primary is unavailable. To register, you will simply need to make a quick phone call to your Resident Services Office (RSO) and they can help you with the rest!

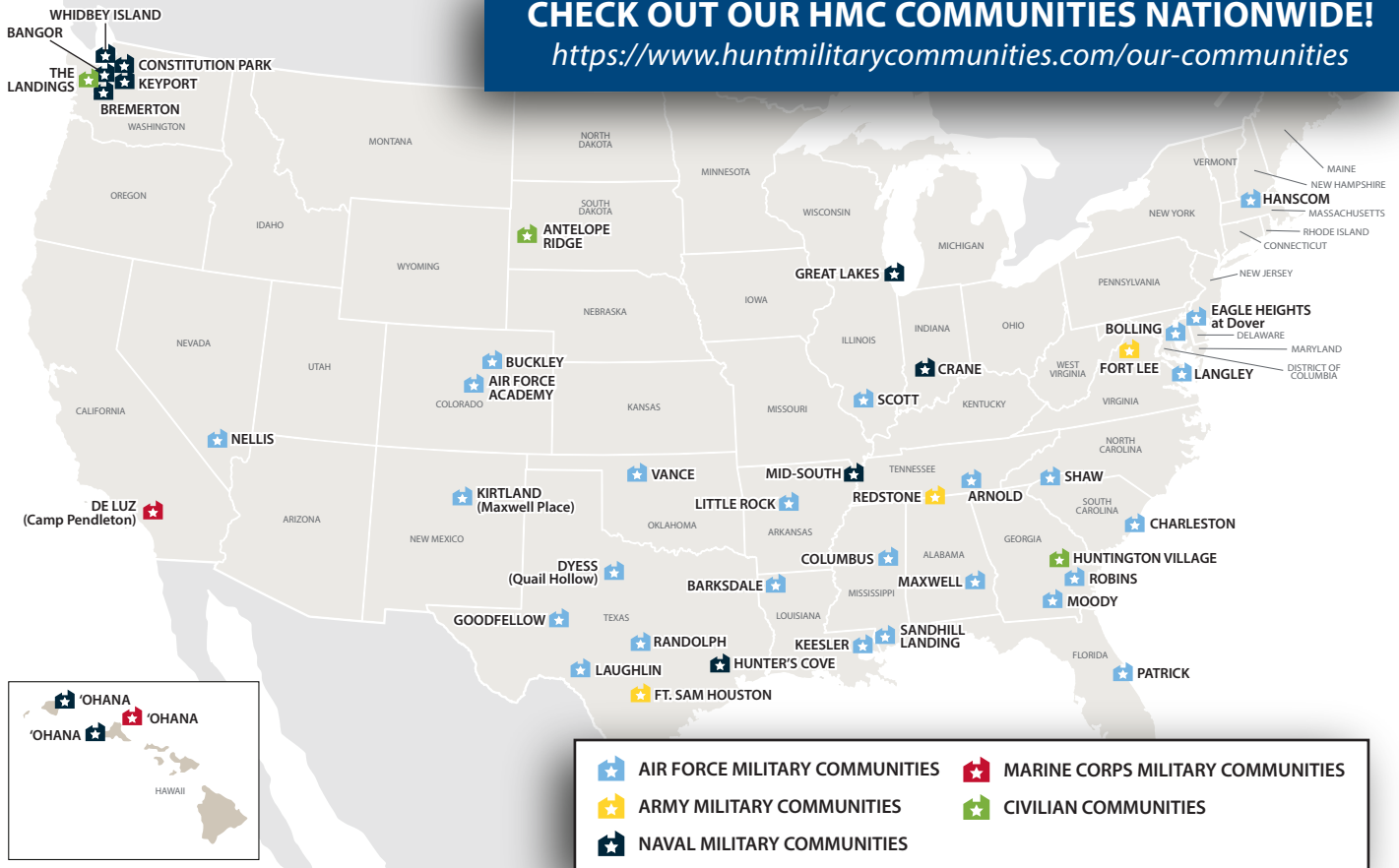
