COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS

Roof Replacement in Hele Mai and Moanalua Terrace!

We are excited to announce our Roof Replacement project has commenced. Over the next year, Moanalua Terrace and Hele Mai will undergo roofing replacements for improvements to the structure of the homes.

The Resident Service Office will provide each resident with proper notification of the scheduling of their home.

Time-line of Work

- Weather permitting, our expected start date is November 1st, 2022, through June 3rd, 2023.
- Repair work for each home will take approximately 1 2 weeks.
- Contractor will place notices on your door when your home is scheduled to start.
- Working hours will be 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday.


Scope of Work

- Protech Roofing who will be taking care of the repair and prep work of the home.
- They will be following strict repair and renovation performance standards.
- The work to be performed will be for exterior work only.
- The work will include roofs on all of the historic homes and both the attached and detached carports belonging to those homes.
 - Removing existing roof and underlayment down to roof sheathing.
 - Removing all existing solar heating panels, drip edges, vents, rain gutters and downspouts.
 - All directly related roofing components will be replaced in kind with new materials (excluding solar water heating panels).
 - The contractor will be responsible for reinstalling solar water heating panels and ensuring the system is fully operational at the completion of the re-installation.
 - Installation of new roofs will include asphalt shingles.

Resident Preparation

In preparation for the work to take place, we ask that you do the following:

- Keep all windows closed for the duration of the project.
- For the two-story buildings, please note that contractors will be working and walking on the lower roof – for your personal privacy, we recommend you keep your windows and shades closed.
- For the two-story homes, the contractor will need to utilize the driveway approach to the carport stall between the hours of 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM, Monday – Friday. We request that you park on the street during that time.
- Please move objects such as patio furniture, signs or toys from the surrounding exterior of the duplexes including backyards. Please be aware that contractors may be entering back yards and the surrounding exterior of the home to complete this task and will clean up all debris.
- Please be aware that some work may hinder access to some entry-exit doors. However, this will be discussed with the resident prior, ensuring that one entry/exit is available.
- Please instruct children to stay clear of the work areas during the project.

PPV Revenue & Expense

- 98% of Revenue pays for Operations and Sustainment
- BAH is the only source of revenue for PPV projects
 - 68% to Operations
 - 47% Operating Expenses
 - 17% Debt Payment
 - 3-4% Project Fee
 - 31% to Project Sustainment
 - Reserves Accounts PRA, ORA,
 - 1-2% Partner Return

Where does my BAH go?





PPV Cash Waterfall

BAH: Only source of revenue for PPV project.



Operating Expenses: Include regular and recurring expenses.



<u>Debt Services:</u> Payment to loan principle and interest.



<u>Reserve Accounts:</u> Funds long term recapitalization of projects through Project Reserves Account.



Project Fees: Includes asset management and PM incentive fees.



Partner Return: PPV return on investment. 90% to Navy held in ORA Account – Funds additional sustainment. 10% to Managing Member (Hunt).
