MAINTENANCE TIPS

Prevent Toilet Troubles

- To maintain your plumbing, only flush toilet paper.
- Even items labeled "flushable," like wipes, can clog pipes.
- Dispose of paper towels, feminine hygiene products, and cotton swabs in the trash.
- A continuously running or slowly flushing toilet may seem a minor issue, but it indicates bigger issues with wastewater.
- If you notice anything unusual, submit a maintenance request promptly. Acting early can prevent repairs and conserve water.

PEST CONTROL TIPS

Stay vigilant year-round to keep your home pest-free. Improperly stored or overflowing trash attracts pests, spreads disease, and creates breeding grounds for flies and roaches. Keeping bins sealed and clean helps protect your home and neighborhood.

Common Pests & Prevention:

- **Flies:** Flies breed fast in warm weather and are drawn to trash and pet waste. Bag trash tightly, keep lids closed, clean bins, and pick up waste—it's not fertilizer and can spread disease.
- **Roaches:** Roaches seek warmth, food, and moisture, especially at night. Keep them out by sealing food, cleaning up crumbs, and using pet-safe pest control.
- Centipedes: Found in mulch and damp areas. Keep doors closed and seek medical help if stung.
- Fleas/Ticks: Frequent vacuuming and promptly emptying vacuum bags helps control fleas.
- Geckos: Not harmful but unwanted indoors. Use eggshells, garlic, or mothballs to deter them.
