#### Welcome Lea'a Puleiala to the East RSO Team at Halsey Community Center!



#### **MAINTENANCE TIPS**

#### **Prepare for Storms or Outages**

Storms and unexpected outages can happen at any time. Here are a few tips to help you stay safe and prepared:

- Build a Basic Emergency Kit: Include flashlights, extra batteries, bottled water, non-perishable snacks, a first aid kit, and any necessary medications.
- Charge Devices in Advance: Keep phones, tablets, and backup power banks fully charged when severe weather is expected.
- Know Who to Call: If you experience a power outage, contact our maintenance line at (808) 784-7800, option 3. Please note that NAVFAC is the agency responsible for managing power-related issues in our communities.
- Unplug Electronics During Outages: To prevent damage from power surges when electricity returns, unplug sensitive electronics like TVs, computers, and gaming systems.
- **Keep Refrigerator & Freezer Closed:** To help prevent food spoilage during a power outage, keep your refrigerator and freezer doors closed as much as possible.
- Use Candles Safely: Never leave them unattended and keep them away from flammable materials. Battery-powered lanterns are a safer alternative.
- **Stay Informed:** Monitor local news or weather apps for updates on outages or storm conditions.
