Monthly Maintenance Tip 101

It is that time of the year again to test your smoke detectors to make sure the batteries are working. Nothing is more irritating then being waken up by a "chirping" smoke alarm. We encourage everyone to check their smoke alarms at least twice a year. In most states, where clocks have to be either fast forwarded an hour in the spring or pushed back an hour in the fall, is normally the signal for us the check our batteries. Since we do not participate in Day Light Savings, we are just sending out a friendly reminder. Most of the smoke detectors require a 9 volt battery, that can be purchased at a store. If you are having a challenge with getting them replaced, please contact us for assistance.
